## WHAT SHOULD I GET TESTED FOR?

WHICH TEST?	HOW DO THEY TEST FOR IT?	HOW DO I KNOW IF I NEED THE TEST?	HOW OFTEN SHOULD I GET TESTED?
HIV	Blood or oral swab	If your last test was negative or you've never been tested	
Syphilis	Blood	No ifs — just get this test! A <i>must</i> for sexually active gay men	
Gonorrhea and chlamydia of the urethra (penis)	Urine*	If you top or get blow jobs	Every 3-6 months, if you're sexually active, regardless of how often you use condoms
Gonorrhea and chlamydia of the rectum (butt)	Rectal (butt) swab*	If you bottom	orten you use condoms
Gonorrhea and chlamydia of the throat	Throat swab*	If you give blow jobs	
Ask your doctor about these other tests that may or may not be right for you: hepatitis B, hepatitis C, and herpes type 2			Ask your doctor

<sup>\*</sup> The **best tests** for gonorrhea and chlamydia are called NAATs, pronounced like "gnats" and short for "nucleic acid amplification tests." **Ask your doctor for them!**
